MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

BETWEEN

KOSOVO CHAMBER OF PHYSIOTHERAPISTS

AND

CHAMBER OF PHYSIOTHERAPISTS OF MONTENEGRO

Prishtina, September 2026

The aim is to foster cooperation and ensure the dignified treatment of physiotherapists, motivated by the desire to collaborate between the two parties in promoting and guaranteeing professional growth, with the objective of exchanging experiences and harmonizing professional standards in line with contemporary trends.

The Parties have reached the following agreement:

MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

Between:

KOSOVO CHAMBER OF PHYSIOTHERAPISTS (hereinafter referred to as KCHPT), with address UCK Complex, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Clinic, 1st Floor, RKS-10000, represented by the president of KCHPT, Mr. Feim Gashi,

and

CHAMBER OF PHYSIOTHERAPISTS OF MONTENEGRO with address Ilije Plamenca, Podgorica 81000, Montenegro represented by the president of Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro, Mr. Dragan Guberinic.

Article 1 - Purpose

1. The purpose of this Memorandum is to establish a framework for professional cooperation between the Parties in the fields of physiotherapy, continuous professional development, exchange of professional experience, ethical standards, and promotion of the physiotherapy profession, within the limits of the Parties statutory competences and applicable laws.

Article 2 - Areas of Cooperation

1. The Parties agree to engage in the following matters related to their activities:

1.1 Continuous contacts between the KCHPT and the Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro to coordinate actions aimed at improving the position of physiotherapists in public and private healthcare institutions at all three levels of the healthcare system.

1.2 Mutual consultation regarding professional issues related to physiotherapy and healthcare activities, with the purpose of implementing legislation and legal and professional standards concerning healthcare services throughout the territory of the Republic of Kosovo and the Montenegro state.

1.3 The Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro shall delegate representatives to bodies and committees for professional consultations upon the request of the KCHPT and vice versa.

1.4 Giving the Parties the information they need to accomplish the goals outlined here.

1.5 The KCHPT and the Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro may establish professional councils, as needed, for addressing specific issues within the physiotherapy sector, subject to mutual agreement.

2. The Parties shall undertake appropriate actions to address the needs referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article, in accordance with the modalities defined in Article 3 of this Memorandum.

Article 3 - Methodology of Cooperation

1. For the purpose of implementing mutual cooperation, the parties agree that the cooperation defined in this memorandum shall be realized through:

1.1 Meetings convened by either Party, as necessary, between representatives of the KCHPT and representatives of the Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro.

1.2 The establishment of working groups for the preparation of various documents related to the implementation of the agreements resulting from this Memorandum.

1.3 Cooperation on joint initiatives for the implementation of specific projects within the scope of the Parties' activities.

2. For any needs related to cooperation practices, the Parties shall coordinate their actions to achieve the objectives expressed in this Memorandum.

3. The types of professional development activities in which the Parties shall cooperate include:

- Joint working groups for conducting various projects/research activities;
- Congresses;
- Seminars;
- Roundtable discussions;
- Conferences;
- Workshops;
- Training programs;
- Courses; and
- Other relevant professional activities.

Participation fees for members shall be equal to those applied to members of the Kosovo Chamber of Physiotherapists and members of the Chamber of Physiotherapists of Montenegro in all activities organised by both Chambers individually or through cooperation.

All activities organized by both Parties shall maintain high professional physiotherapy standards.

All organized activities shall be delivered by professionals licensed for the respective activity.

All activities organized by both organizations shall include a detailed program and agenda.

Organized activities should be recognized by the World Physiotherapy (formerly WCPT) and the World Health Organization (WHO).

Activities organized by either Parties under this Memorandum that are unrelated to physiotherapy or medicine and that involve alternative medicine practices shall not be recognized or accepted by the parties.

Any professional development activity intended to be recognised for licensing, relicensing or continuing professional development purposes shall be subject to the applicable accreditation and recognition procedures of the competent Party and shall not be deemed automatically recognised by virtue of this Memorandum.

Article 4 - Means of Communication

1. The Parties agree that all matters shall be communicated through authorized officials directly. Each Party shall communicate the names of its authorized officials through an official written notification issued by the competent authority.
2. Communication between authorized officials shall be carried out, but not limited to, direct meetings, formal correspondence by mail, and electronic communication. In all cases where a request is submitted, the Parties undertake to provide a response within ten (10) days.

Article 5 - Financial Costs

Any financial costs arising from the implementation of this Memorandum of Cooperation shall be borne by the Parties in accordance with a prior agreement reached between them.

Article 6 - Amendments and Duration

1. This Memorandum may be amended only with the written approval of both Parties.
2. Any dispute regarding the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum shall be resolved amicably between the Parties.
3. This Memorandum shall enter into force upon signature by the Parties and shall remain valid for an indefinite period.

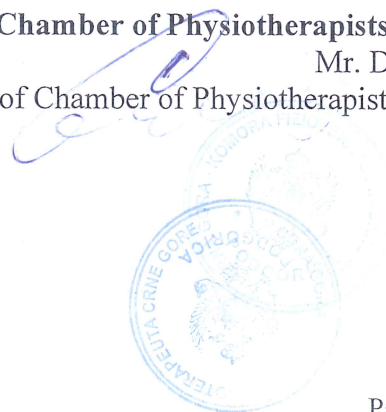
